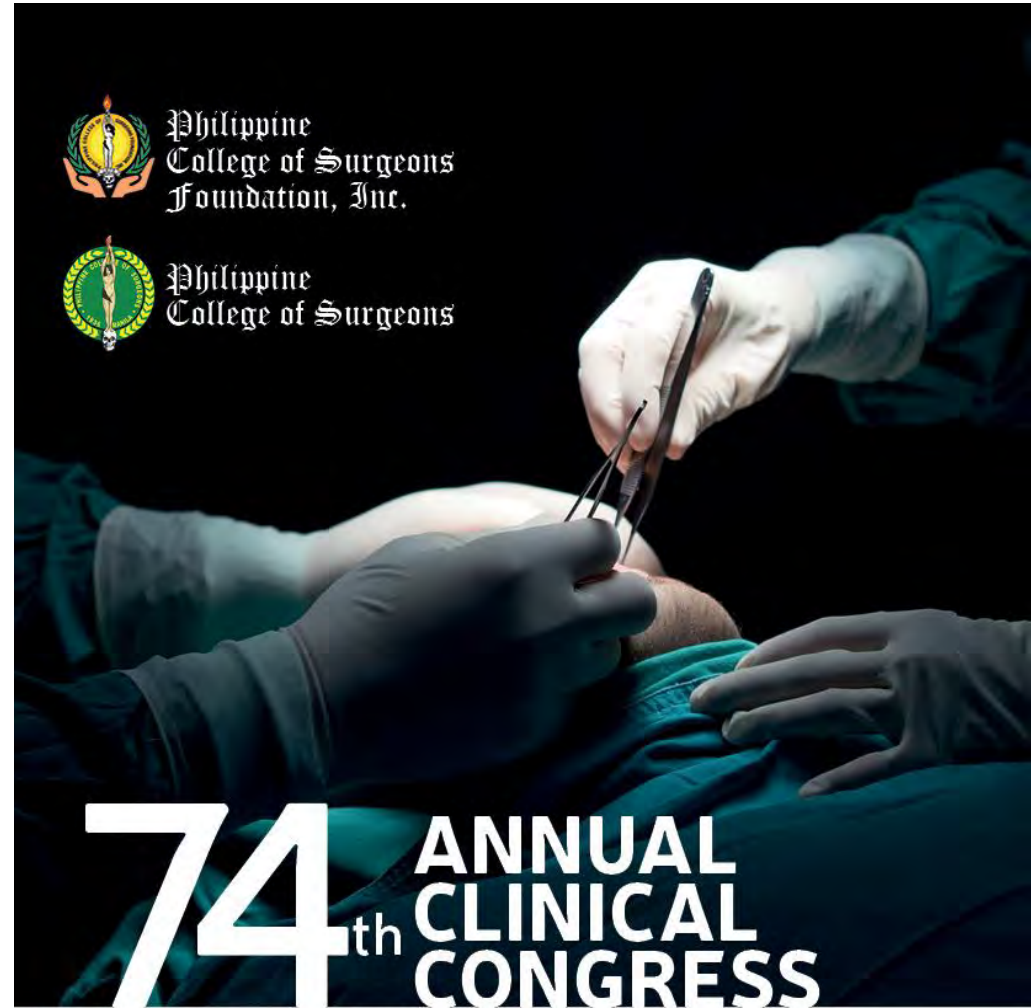

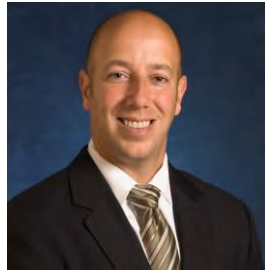

Charms of Old Manila for **FIRST TIME VISITORS**



Take a step back in time as you discover the **"Charms of Old Manila"**. The tour starts with a visit to historic **Rizal Park**, where the remains of our country's national hero, **Dr. Jose Rizal**, lie within the cornerstone of Rizal Monument. Tour heads on to the old walled city of Intramuros built during the Spanish colonial period. The first stop is **Fort Santiago** which served as headquarters of the military might of the Spanish, American and Japanese colonizers until its destruction in 1945. Tour then proceeds past the **San Agustin Church**, the oldest structure in the country which dates back to 1571. The next stop is **Casa Manila**, a reconstructed 19th century mansion replete with 16th to 19th century furniture and furnishings. The last stop is **Baluarte de San Diego**, the only battery directly facing the sea.

INVIGORATING TAGAYTAY (approximately 8 hours)

This unique musical instrument is composed of 1,031 pipes, and 902 of which are made out of bamboo while the rest are metal.
